Introduction

Some say that it takes 21 days to break a bad habit or to form a new habit. I believe this same principle can apply to overcoming obstacles and achieving personal breakthroughs. The obstacles we face may be broken relationships, health problems, job insecurity, financial troubles, concerns about the future, doubts about our faith, temptations we can't seem to overcome, foundless fears, or any number of situations. The key to breakthrough in these areas? Taking them to God.

The 21 prayers and scriptures in this book will help you create a closer relationship and communication with God. God wants to hear your concerns, but he also wants to reveal a message to you. He wants you to experience breakthrough in your spirit, in your soul, in your family, in your relationships, in your finances, and your job. He wants to renew your vision and dreams. He wants to renew heart in those who have lost heart. He also wants to remove the cynicism that would have you say, "I've done this before and nothing happened." That's the enemy dropping his seeds of doubt. The Holy Spirit is not a doubter. The Holy Spirit says, "This is a new time."

God can work a miracle in your life. God can work a miracle in your circumstance. Jeremiah 33:3 says: "Call to me and I will answer you." We could all use a few answers—answers to prayers and answers to questions. "I will answer you," God promises. But God doesn't stop there. He adds: "And I will show you great and mighty things."

I find that the more I live in myself, the more I live with worldly energy and thoughts. When I believe as the world does that only those things I see, smell, touch, and hear are real, the less I think about great and mighty things. I settle for little and weak things. Little prayers. Weak living. Little answers.

If I allow myself to be away from prayer and away from the Word and

away from the invisible Kingdom of God, I don't see the possibilities. Only through prayer and the Word can we touch the real world, which is the spiritual world, the world that God rules, the world that God moves in, the world that is faith-filled and miracle-filled. That world has a lot of different ideas in it: Nothing is impossible. All things are possible. I will answer you. *Great and mighty things.*

This can be just another year in your life or it can be a great and mighty year, a time of personal breakthrough. The essence of breakthrough is trusting and believing that God is in control and that He is Lord, and all things are working together every day for your good.

I strongly recommend that you read aloud both the prayers and the scriptures presented in this book. Speaking the words rather than passively reading them brings action and power to the prayers and verses, a power that dissolves bonds and breaks down obstacles. Take time to listen, too. God wants to bring you a message and wants you to know there is an appointed time for that message.

I pray this three-week focus on breakthrough will transform your life, your relationships, and your future for the glory of God. I pray you will grow in favor and encounter miracles and that God will pour out blessings and favor throughout your life.

Day One

Blessing and Favor upon My Year

In Jesus' name, by the power of the blood shed on the cross, by the authority of the scriptures, I proclaim a mighty blessing upon my life, my now, and my future, and all that pertains to my life, my health, my home, my finances, my friends, and my church. I proclaim this year to be a year of favor, blessing, new spiritual power, increase, expansion, fresh anointing, and great personal breakthrough for the glory of God.

Deuteronomy 11:8-15

Therefore you shall keep every commandment which I command you today, that you may be strong, and go in and possess the land which you cross over to possess, and that you may prolong your days in the land which the LORD swore to give your fathers, to them and their descendants, 'a land flowing with milk and honey.' For the land which you go to possess is not like the land of Egypt from which you have come, where you sowed your seed and watered it by foot, as a vegetable garden; but the land which you cross over to possess is a land of hills and valleys, which drinks water from the rain of heaven, a land for which the LORD your God cares; the eyes of the LORD your God are always on it, from the beginning of the year to the very end of the year. 'And it shall be that if you earnestly obey My commandments which I command you today, to love the LORD your God and serve Him with all your heart and with all your soul, then I will give you the rain for your land in its season, the early rain and the latter rain, that you may gather in your grain, your new wine, and your oil. And I will send grass in your fields for your livestock, that you may eat and be filled.'

You water its ridges abundantly, You settle its furrows; You make it soft with showers, You bless its growth. You crown the year with Your goodness, and Your paths drip with abundance. They drop on the pastures of the wilderness, and the little hills rejoice on every side. The pastures are clothed with flocks; the valleys also are covered with grain; they shout for joy, they also sing.

Psalm 102:12-18

But You, O LORD, shall endure forever, and the remembrance of Your name to all generations. You will arise and have mercy on Zion; for the time to favor her, Yes, the set time, has come. For Your servants take pleasure in her stones, and show favor to her dust. So the nations shall fear the name of the LORD, and all the kings of the earth Your glory. For the LORD shall build up Zion; He shall appear in His glory. He shall regard the prayer of the destitute, and shall not despise their prayer. This will be written for the generation to come, that a people yet to be created may praise the LORD.

Day Two

You crown my year with Your goodness. My paths drip with abundance. My decisions are protected by Your grace and mercy. Your hand of blessing and favor rests mightily upon me this year. You surround me like a shield and defend me from my enemies. I know You have planned great things for my life, and my future is awesome because of You!

Psalm 84:11

For the LORD God is a sun and shield; the LORD will give grace and glory; no good thing will He withhold from those who walk uprightly.

Jeremiah 29:11

For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the LORD, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope.

Now therefore, listen to me, my children, for blessed are those who keep my ways. Hear instruction and be wise, and do not disdain it. Day Three

Blessing and Favor on My Finances

Thank You Lord, that I have received instructions from your word on how to order my finances. I am blessed so that I can be a blessing to my family, my friends, my church, and my world. I have made the decision to put You first in my life as well as my finances. I have committed my first 10 percent to You all the days of my life and from my surplus, I will be liberal and generous. I thank You for Your faithful provision, for the windows of heaven being opened over my life, for the barns filled with plenty, for the pressing down and overflowing of Your amazing blessings. The continued force of your blessings has created a supernatural breakthrough in my finances. Thank You Lord, for the flow of Your grace toward my life.

Genesis 17:1

Let my faith generate spiritual breakthrough: a faith that sees the invisible, believes the incredible, and receives the impossible.

Day Five

Blessing and Favor on My Marriage and Family

Lord, I pray You deliver my soul from the lies and attacks of the enemy that would sow wrong thoughts or wrong thinking that causes a wrong perspective on my marriage. I align myself to Your word, O Lord. Your word confirms marriage to be holy and a God-made institution, a marriage between one man and one woman, a marriage that is to last a lifetime, a marriage that is to bring forth children who will become a blessing. Lord, I believe that even my worst days are never so bad that you cannot reach into my marriage and change me, make me, and restore me. Lord, bless my marriage, my children, and children's children. Lord, provide that right mate for my children. Lord, bless every area of my life and my marriage, my family, my home. Create a momentum within our family tree that will carry the blessing of a godly marriage and family.

Genesis 2:18-25

And the LORD God said, "It is not good that man should be alone; I will make him a helper comparable to him." Out of the ground the LORD God formed every beast of the field and every bird of the air, and brought them to Adam to see what he would call them. And whatever Adam called each living creature, that was its name. So Adam gave names to all cattle, to the birds of the air, and to every beast of the field. But for Adam there was not found a helper comparable to him. And the LORD God caused a deep sleep to fall on Adam, and he slept; and He took one of his ribs, and closed up the flesh in its place. Then the rib which the LORD God had taken from man He made into a woman, and He brought her to the man. And Adam said: "This is now bone of my bones and flesh of my flesh; she shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man." Therefore a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and they shall become one flesh. And they were both naked, the man and his wife, and were not ashamed.

Day Six

Teach me to put my whole heart and soul into my work, to serve with integrity, to obey and respect those over me, and to make the business prosper. Lord, give me a diligent heart at and for my work, a working hand with careful effort attitude. Help me to be industrious, accomplishing what my responsibility requires of me. Lord, I know You desire to bless and prosper me in my work, to help me provide new ideas and create a personal breakthrough around my job, my business, my world of work. Lord, let me remember You have redeemed my work from the curse and that work under the Lordship of Christ can be fulfilling, satisfying, and exciting, bringing glory to You. Thank you Lord, for what You are about to do in and through my work.

Colossians 3:23-24

And whatever you do, do it heartily, as to the Lord and not to men, knowing that from the Lord you will receive the reward of the inheritance; for you serve the Lord Christ.

Ephesians 6:5-8

Bondservants, be obedient to those who are your masters according to the flesh, with fear and trembling, in sincerity of heart, as to Christ; not with eye service, as men-pleasers, but as bondservants of Christ, doing the will of God from the heart, with goodwill doing service, as to the Lord, and not to men, knowing that whatever good anyone does, he will receive the same from the Lord, whether he is a slave or free.

Day Seven

Blessing and Favor on My Thinking

Lord, I pray that You would help me align my thought life to You, Your word, and Your Holy Spirit. I know my thoughts will determine the level of my spiritual health and ultimately my spiritual destiny. Lord, teach me to weigh my thoughts and choose those thoughts that are pure and pleasing to You. Help me Lord to win the battle over the evil or dark thoughts the enemy desires to throw toward my mind. Lord, teach me and enable me to control my thinking, to guard my thoughts, and to resist the enemy of my soul. Convert my mind, alter, and mold my mind according to Your word. Create in me a new thought process, a new thought discipline. Let there be a breakthrough in me to renew my mind and think the thoughts of You!

Romans 12:3

For I say, through the grace given to me, to everyone who is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think, but to think soberly, as God has dealt to each one a measure of faith.

Day Eight

New Spiritual Power to Resist the Enemy

Lord, grant me the spiritual understanding of how I can resist the devil. I have faith and I stand against the enemy through the power of Jesus' name. God is my shield and my refuge, a very present help in time of trouble. When the enemy comes against my soul, the Holy Spirit will raise a standard against Him. The Lord will be my strength and I shall not be moved. I shall stand my ground in the day of battle. When my soul is attacked by a series of unusual bad experiences, irritations, and small calamities, I will resist the devil's lies by standing with my spiritual armor. I shall not be moved, for greater is He who is in me than He that is in the world. I pray the word of God. I submit to You, O Lord. I resist the devil and I demand that He flee from me. I draw near to You, Lord, with a pure heart and a faith in Your power.

James 4:7-8

Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you. Draw near to God and He will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners; and purify your hearts, you double-minded.

1 Peter 5:8-9

Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour. Resist him, steadfast in the faith, knowing that the same sufferings are experienced by your brotherhood in the world.

Leviticus 26:8

Five of you shall chase a hundred, and a hundred of you shall put ten thousand to flight; your enemies shall fall by the sword before you.

2 Corinthians 2:11

Lest Satan should take advantage of us; for we are not ignorant of his devices.

Genesis 49:22-24

Joseph is a fruitful bough, a fruitful bough by a well; his branches run over the wall. The archers have bitterly grieved him, shot at him and hated him. But his bow remained in strength, and the arms of his hands were made strong by the hands of the Mighty God of Jacob (from there is the Shepherd, the Stone of Israel).

Stand therefore, having girded your waist with truth, having put on the breastplate of righteousness, and having shod your feet with the preparation of

the gospel of peace; above all, taking the shield of faith with which you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one. And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God; praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints.

Day Ten
